The cost of these sessions are £30 per term, which needs to be paid in advance via their website https://venturecamps.co.uk/clubs/ These football sessions are a great environment for children to be able to learn the skills and tactics involved with playing football whilst giving them the opportunity to make friends. The sessions are catered all the way from beginner to experienced players and focus solely on developing skills and knowledge of the game. Each week will focus on a different skill with various drills that lead into a match at the end of the session for the children to display what they've learnt in a competitive setting. Venture football is committed to enhancing children's engagement within football.

The children will need shin pads, a drink and football boots. They will meet their coach in Year 3 Bumblebees classroom at 3:20pm each Monday.
