



Admissions for Pre-School Age Children

This information is provided for parents of children who are not yet old enough to apply for a place at primary school.

If your child was born between 1 September 2013 and 31 August 2014 please see our 'September 2018 Admissions' information.

If your child isn't old enough to start school yet you may register an interest by contacting our school office. Please note that registering an interest **does not** give your child priority for a place at our school.

When your child is old enough the school will contact you so that you can complete a Reception Common Admissions Form (RCAF). Parents can do this online at www.kent.gov.uk/ola, usually between November and January. If you do not have access to the internet you can request a paper copy of the application form from the school office.

The RCAF must be completed and submitted by the deadline indicated on the form for your child to be considered at any primary school.

The number of children admitted into the Foundation year group at Godinton Primary School is 60. If more than 60 pupils wish to join our Foundation year group, places will be allocated according to our Admission Oversubscription Criteria.
