	Poetry	<p>To listen and respond to poems.</p> <p>Learn part of a poem off by heart</p> <p>Use clear, audible voices</p> <p>Repeat familiar lines in a wellknown poem</p> <p>To identify rhyme within a poem</p> <p>Listen to the ideas of others.</p> <p>Say a poem with actions. 	<b>Cultural Stories</b>	<p>To be able to spell known high frequency words accurately.</p> <p>To retell the story using words and actions.</p> <p>To identify cultural similarities and differences in stories.</p> <p>To identify differences in settings and characters in stories from other cultures.</p> <p>To sequence a story using adjectives</p> <p>Use their knowledge of the story to retell it in their own words</p> <p>Create props to help retell the story</p> <p>Use adjectives in their retelling.</p> <p>To plan a story , identifying beginning and middle of the story</p>
