Write a speech about something you would like to change about the world. What would you like to change and why? How would you bring about this change? How might others react? Create Top Trump cards for Emmaline Pankhurst, Millicent Fawcett, Muriel Matters, Emily Davison and Marion Dunlop.
Find out about women's right to vote today in 2025. Can all women vote equally with men all around the world? Use a map to help you present this research.	Write a letter to one of the suffragettes we have studied informing them of what impact their contribution has had on 21st Century Britain.	Create a poster encouraging people to join the movement for women's suffrage.
Design a board game to teach other students about Women's Suffrage.	Write a diary entry from the perspective of a suffragette who has just attended a protest.	Create a timeline of key events in the suffragette movement (the presentation can be as creative as you like).
