


# Eagles and Falcons' Homework Trail (Term 4 2025–2026)

Write a newspaper report detailing how the change to immigration law affected those who had come to Britain before 1971.</p>	<p>Choose a Caribbean island that we have studied and design a persuasive leaflet that would encourage tourists to visit the island. Make sure you use all the elements of the tourism industry to tempt them.</p>
<p>We challenge you to read 6 books this term. They need to be by different authors and at least 2 different genres. Write a short book review about each one: include author, illustrator and synopsis.</p>	<p>Create a piece of artwork on the theme of trees.</p>	<p>Chose an area that you know well, draw a map and plan an orienteering route. Challenge a member of your family to complete the route.</p>
