Spellings

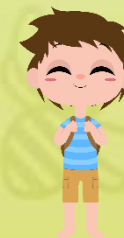
Practice a couple of the spellings from spelling lists at the front of your homework book each week. Practise reading and writing: **because, people, once, were, little, whole.**

Focus on using neat handwriting, finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.</p> | <p>Draw and label an animal that you might see at the seaside.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you write a few facts about your chosen creature.</p> |
| <p>Our superhero this term is Greta Thunburg. Can you research who she is and write 3 or more facts about why she is special.</p> | <p>Choose a beach from around the world and compare it with a beach from the UK. What is the same? What is different? Write, draw or stick pictures to show what you have found.</p> | <p>If you are able to, take a trip to the seaside! Use your senses to make a list of the things you can see, hear, smell, feel and possibly taste!</p> |
