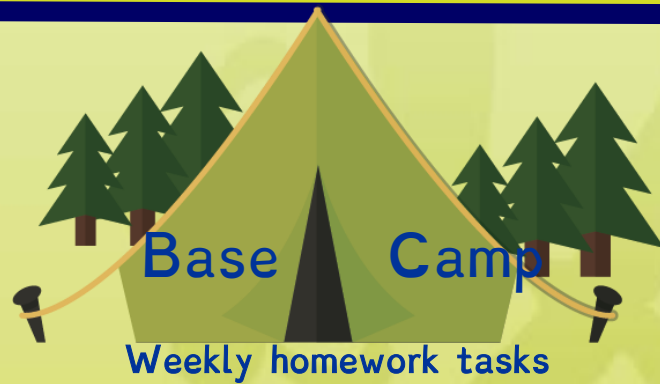


Bumblebees and Dragonflies Homework Trail (Term 5 2025–2026)
