You must complete three squares in a row, passing vertically, horizontally or diagonally through the middle square.

<p><u>Can you go a colour walk?</u> Can you go on a colour walk with a grown up? Can you take a picture of the favourite thing you spot on your walk? Can you complete some 'What am I?' clues for your colour walk?</p>	<p><u>Sing a Song!</u> Can you learn and perform a song that features a king, queen or soldier? If you're feeling brave, you can ask a grown up to film it and add it to tapestry.</p>	<p><u>Coat of Arms</u> A coat of arms is the name for the colourful decoration that knights had on their shields or on parts of their clothing. Can you design a coat of arms for your family?</p>
<p><u>Deck of Cards</u> Can you find all the heart cards in a deck and put them in the right order? Can you find which pairs of cards go together to make 5 or 10? You could also use the cards to explore 'doubles'. Can you invent your own card game?</p>	<p><u>A Royal Feast</u> Can you bake something fit for a king with your grown up? You could create a 'Royal' menu fit for a King or Queen.</p>	<p><u>Can you make a castle?</u> Can you make a castle? Can you name the features of a castle? Perhaps you have visited a castle recently and have taken some photos that you can share with us?</p>
<p><u>A Royal Crown</u> Can you design a crown for the King? Can you find out about some of the things he likes to help inform your design? Can you also label your design?</p>	<p><u>Dragon 'Tales'</u> Can you share a dragon related story and create a 3D dragon model or painting that you can either bring to school or photograph for Tapestry?</p>	<p><u>Long Ago.....</u> Can you be a 'Royal Investigator'? Delve into the past and find out some facts about a famous King or Queen.</p>
