Admission of Children into the Reception Classes

This information is for parents with children born between 1 September 2022 and 31 August 2023, who will be due to start school in September 2027.

If your child is not old enough to start school yet, you may register an interest by contacting our school office. Please note that registering an interest does not give your child priority for a place at our school.

The number of children admitted into the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) year group (Reception Classes) at Godinton Primary School is 60. If more than 60 pupils wish to join our Reception year group, places will be allocated according to our Admission Oversubscription Criteria. A full list of our over subscription criteria can be found on the admissions page on our website.

Applying for a place at Godinton Primary School

Applications for transfer to primary school for September 2027 open on Friday 6th November 2026 and close at midnight on Friday 15th January 2027. The method of application is the completion of the KCC online Reception Common Admissions Form (RCAF).

Parents can apply for up to three schools, putting them in order of preference. It is in your best interests to list three schools. Naming only one school does not guarantee your child a place at that school or give your child priority for a place over another child, neither does naming a school more than once.

The Processing of Applications

Applications will close on Friday 15th January 2027 for children due to start primary in September 2027. If you miss the deadline, please email primaryadmissions@kent.gov.uk.

KCC process applications between 16th January and 15th April 2027.

If you apply online, KCC will email you on Friday 16th April 2027 after 4pm to tell you which school you have been offered. They cannot guarantee the exact time you will receive your email; this will depend on your email service provider.

You can also log in from 5pm on 16th April 2027 to view your offer.

We will send out welcome letters to parents who have been successful in gaining a place at Godinton after this date.

Accepting a School Place Offer

You will need to accept or refuse the offer directly to the school. The deadline for returning the primary acceptance/refusal form is Friday 30th April 2027.

Once you have accepted your child's place, you will be notified by the school of all the exciting opportunities over the coming months when we will start the process of getting to know you and your child. This includes a parents welcome meeting, stay and play sessions, story time sessions and an invitation to have lunch at school. Staff will also make nursery visits and home visits in order to help them in getting to know your child.

Making an Appeal

If you have been refused a place at our school you can appeal against that decision. You can lodge an appeal between 16th April and 17th May 2027.
