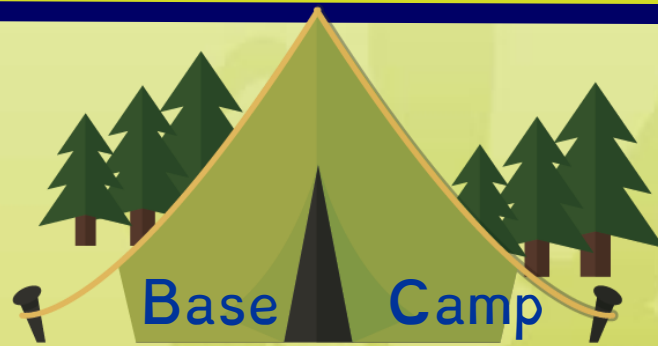


Foxes and Otters Homework Trail (Term 1 2026–2027)



Weekly homework tasks

Reading

It is key to show your child that reading is something to be enjoyed. Read or share a book at least five times a week. This could be a bedtime story or sharing a story in different places i.e. the beach. Please remember to share the Little Wandle book at home.

Mathletics and Time Tables

Tasks will be set on Mathletics weekly. You can use the games and challenges on Mathletics as often as you like. The more, the better! Practise counting forwards and backwards and learn simple number bonds e.g. $7+3=10$.

Spellings

Practice spelling CVC words (dig, hat, man) and CVCC words (frog, lost, swim, shop, bang, trap). Can you practise some 'tricky words' (words that cannot be sounded out) e.g. the, was, are, you, come, like, little, one, they.

Off on the trail...



You must complete three squares in a row, passing vertically, horizontally or diagonally through the middle square.

Create a game linked to number bonds to 5 or 10 or 20 or 100. Take a picture of yourselves playing with the game.	Find out about a toy from the past that a family member may have played with. How have our toys changed? Can you create an information book about it? You can either use drawings or photographs to illustrate your book.	Create a timeline of yourself from being a baby to now. You can use photos, pictures or words to show significant events.
This term our class hero is Frida Kahlo. Can you research and write 3 (or more) facts about her?	Create an 'All About Me' poster using pictures, photographs and simple sentences. (You could include: family, hobbies, likes/dislikes etc)	Create a family tree to show all of your family members. How far back can you go? Can you be creative with how you present this?
Create an athletic challenge for yourself i.e. how many star jumps can you complete in a minute or how far can you jump? Take photos of your different activities.	Find a song with lyrics which are about feeling happy, being proud of yourself or all being different etc and film yourselves singing or dancing to it and send to the Year One email.	Design, create and make a new teddy or toy for a small child. Complete a leaflet to advertise its sale in a shop.
