Read or share a book at least five times a week. This could be your school reading book or a book from home.

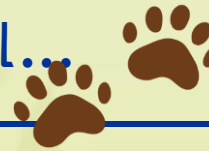
Mathletics

Off on the trail...



You must complete three squares in a row, passing vertically, horizontally or diagonally through the middle square.

Design and make your own Labyrinth. It could be made of straws, string, wood or any other material you wish.

Who was Marie Curie? Find out all about her life and why her work was so important to us today. How will you present your research?

Create a leaflet for people visiting Greece. Include things like: local cuisine, currency, famous landmarks, bordering countries and interesting facts. Can you draw the flag on it too?

Find out about the clothes Ancient Greeks wore. You could draw and label a picture showing a typical Ancient Greek outfit, or create one which you could wear.

Create an information booklet about some of the Greek Gods. Make sure your booklet is eye-catching and full of facts and information.

Create your own Ancient Greek artefact at home. Which style and structure will you replicate?

Read some Ancient Greek Myths. Share your recommendations.

Which ones did you enjoy? Why? What do you think the lessons they were trying to teach were?

Find out some simple Greek phrases. E.g. Hello, How are you? What's your name? etc. Can you make a poster to display them in Greek & English? Make sure you can pronounce them correctly and teach them to the class!

Create a new law. What would your law be? Why should it be agreed by parliament? What do you have to support your idea? What would you say to people who oppose your idea?
