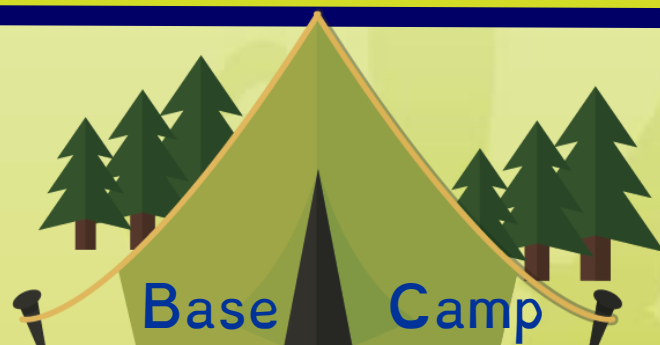


Cuckoos' and Magpies' Homework Trail (Term 1 2026–2027)

Tasks will set on Mathletics each week. You can use the games and challenges available on Mathletics as often as you like. The more, the better! Practice the times tables facts that have been sent home.

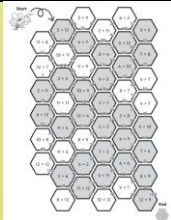
Spelling

Off on the trail...



You must complete three squares in a row, passing vertically, horizontally or diagonally through the middle square.

This term our hero is <i>Alan Turing</i>. Read and research a range of sources to gather information about him. What were his achievements? Why do you think he has been chosen as one of our Year Group Heroes?	Draw or paint a picture or scene from the Victorian times, e.g. Queen Victoria on the throne, a matchbox girl on the street, a poor family eating dinner.	 Create your own multiplication maze where the correct facts lead you through. You could make an answer sheet too.
Design an outfit for a rich or poor person to wear in the Victorian era.	Write a diary entry from a child who lives in the poor house. Talk about your day, how you feel and what type of things you do.	Create a job advert for someone to work as a maid in a rich household. Your advert should be well written with clarity. It should include how much a maid would be paid.
Create / practise an outdoor game for Victorian children to play.	Write a short newspaper article announcing Queen Victoria's Coronation. Include: a catchy headline, columns and captions for any pictures.	Make a 3D object from Victorian times.
