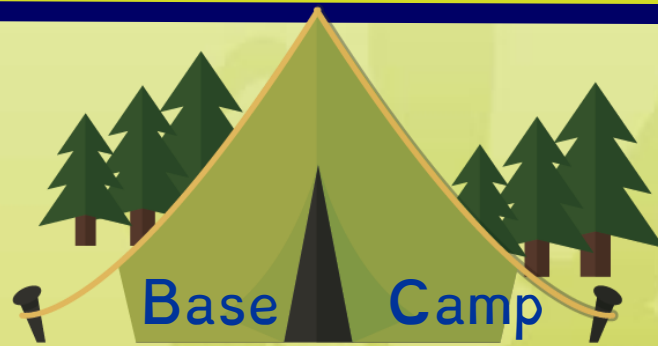


Eagles' and Falcons' Homework Trail (Term 1 2026–2027)

Reading

Off on the trail...



You must complete three squares in a row, passing vertically, horizontally or diagonally through the middle square.

This term our hero is Ellie Simmonds. Research and find out about her. What were her achievements? Why do you think she has been chosen as one of our Year Group Heroes?	Draw or paint a picture or scene from the Medieval times, e.g. typical town life, the royal court, a Medieval church service.	Spend time with your family. Write and take photos of a journey you make together. This could be a journey of any length to any place.
Create a board game for you and your friends. The game must have challenge cards which are linked to the four operations. Remember to include rules to your game.	Research and write an account about a famous explorer (past or present) and the journey they have made. Include a map of the route that they took.	Create a piece of 3-D artwork based on the theme of 'Journey of Discovery'.
Carry out a science or technology experiment looking at movement or change. Useful ideas: https://sciencebob.com/category/experiments	Read 3 books by an author that you haven't read before.	Design an outfit for a knight, a baron or a peasant to wear in the Medieval era.
